Code of Conduct

Role for Underage players

- 1.1 Play fairly, do your best and enjoy yourself.
- 1.2 Represent your family and your club with Pride.
- 1.3 Players must wear the club colours for all games:
Black togs & Black / amber socks

RESPECT:

- 1.4 Respect officials and accept their decisions gracefully.
- 1.5 Respect fellow team mates giving them support when they do well and not so well.
- 1.6 Respect your opponents
 - Shake hands before and after the game irrespective of the result.
 - Accept apologies from opponents when they are offered.

FAIRNESS:

- 1.7 Let the coach know when you are unavailable for Games / Training
- 1.8 Approach the team coach with any problems you may have.
- 1.9 **DO NOT**
 - Shout or argue with a team mentor
 - Bully or take an unfair advantage of another team mate
 - Tell lies about adults or other team members
- 1.10 Players must NOT:
 - Use bad language or swear while training / playing for the club.
 - Interfere or damage club property or the property of other clubs

Failure to adhere to this code of conduct may lead to initial warnings and if it continues disciplinary action.

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Code of Conduct

Role for the Coach / Team Mentor

- 2.1 *Coaching Motto: Children First / Winning second.*
- 2.2 Regard the rights, dignity and worth of every person and treat each one equally regardless of age, gender and ability.
- 2.3 Be punctual, properly attired, lead by example, NO smoking or the consumption of alcohol in the presence of young people.
- 2.4 *Encouragement:* Children respond better to praise and encouragement so coaches should always be positive in their approach.
- 2.5 Don't shout at or lecture players or reprimand/ridicule them when they make a mistake. *Children learn best from trial and error – They should not be afraid to risk error to learn.*
- 2.6 Don't equate losing with failure. *The level of improvement made by young players is the best indicator of Coaching effectiveness.*
- 2.7 Never use foul language or provocative language / gestures to a player, opponent or match official. Do not question the referee's decisions.
- 2.8 Do not be alone in a car or dressing room with a player.
- 2.9 Do not take coaching sessions on your own. Encourage parents / guardians to play an active role in training, at games etc.

Role for the Parents / Guardians

Parents should not attempt to meet their own needs for success and achievement through their children participation in Gaelic Games.
